Music Director of 2025 Weiwuying Organ Festival **Wayne MARSHALL**

British conductor, organist and pianist, Wayne MARSHALL, is world-renowned for his musicianship and versatility on the podium and at the keyboard. He has served as Chief Conductor of WDR Funkhausorchester, Cologne (2014–2020) and Principal Guest Conductor of Orchestra Sinfonica di Milano Giuseppe Verdi (2007–2013).

As an organ recitalist, he has an exceptionally varied repertoire and performs across the globe. In recent years, he has gained a significant following on social media.

During 2024, he performed at the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles, Essen Philharmonie, Brussels Cathedral and at the Royal Albert Hall in London for the 150th-anniversary celebrations of the Henry WILLS organ. Earlier this year, he gave Organ Recitals at the Royal Festival Hall and Norwich Cathedral in June 2025.

In the autumn of the 2025 season, MARSHALL is performing a series of concerts at the Weiwuying Organ Festival in Taiwan. He is also giving an organ recital in Dudelange, followed immediately by an extensive recital tour in China. He will also perform and conduct at the Lucerne Festival to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the KKL Organ.

His many honours include an Honorary Doctorate from Bournemouth University (2004), a Fellowship of the Royal College of Music (2010) and the Golden Jubilee Award from the Government of Barbados (2016). In 2021 MARSHALL was awarded an OBE (Officer of the British Empire) by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. In March 2024, MARSHALL was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from Coventry University.

Wayne MARSHALL is proud to be an Ambassador of the London Music Fund, a Charity whose mission is to support the children of underprivileged communities to have access to high-quality music education.
