SCHUBERT in 2022, MOZART in 2023, and BEETHOVEN in 2024. The fourth edition of Weiwuying's 24 Hours series, an event for which music by a single composer is played continuously for 24 hours, is in the works. This time, we'll leave the Austro-German tradition of the previous three editions for the beloved Russian master of melody, TCHAIKOVSKY!

Born in 1840, TCHAIKOVSKY cleverly blended Slavic folk and Austro-German orthodoxy to bring the late Romantic period to a new height. His work includes symphonies, concertos, operas, and chamber pieces. Also of great importance is his music for ballets, which adds so much to the dancing but can be equally enjoyed alone, hence its popularity holding strong to the present.

Nine days after the debut of his greatest masterpiece, Symphony No. 6, *Pathétique*, TCHAIKOVSKY passed away at the age of 53, his death somewhat of a mystery and, of course, leaving fans anguished. Without any reservation, he composed these completely human pieces about his frustrations and pain in life, and it still moves people deeply. *24 Hours TCHAIKOVSKY* kicks off at 5:00 p.m. on February 22, 2025. Come to the Concert Hall, Recital Hall, and other spaces at Weiwuying to immerse yourself in his mesmerizing, thoroughly touching melodies!
